Free Assistance Over-the-Phone!

"Extra Help" is a Medicare program to help people with limited income and resources pay Medicare prescription drug (Part D) costs.

Ohio Senior Health Insurance Information Program (OSHIIP) trained staff are ready to answer questions, share information about Medicare Savings options, and help callers apply, right over phone!

Some people automatically qualify for "Extra Help."

You automatically qualify for Extra Help if you:

- Have Medicare
- Are over the age of 65
- Have full Medicaid coverage
- Receive help from Ohio's Medicaid program paying your Part B premiums (in a Medicaid Savings Program)
- Receive Supplemental Security Income (SSI) benefits



Save on Prescription Costs!

- Talk to your insurance provider about formulary medications and preferred pharmacies
- Ask your doctor about less expensive brand name drugs
- Consider mail order pharmacy options

Medicare Open Enrollment

Your health needs can change from year to year - so do Medicare plan costs and coverage.
