## What is the STIP?

• The Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) is Ohio's 4-year transportation planned program that identifies a prioritized list of projects scheduled for some phase of implementation.


## How does a project get into the STIP?

- Funding is secured and work on any phase will occur within the 4-year STIP period.
  - Federally or State funded or be regionally significant\*



## WHEN & HOW IS THE STIP DEVELOPED

- STIP development occurs every 2 years
- Collaborative effort between ODOT, MPOs, RTPOs, & Rural Officials





# What is STIP Rural Consultation?

- Time for ODOT to meet with rural local officials specifically on the STIP development
- Time for Rural Local Officials to provide input on regional transportation needs and on planned projects in the 4-year STIP period








#### DRAFT 2026-2029 STIP PROJECT MAPS – BH REGION




2026 - 2029 Construction Projects HOCKING County
