APPENDIX A

OTHER RELEVANT FACTORS

- Projects that have all funding secured and are ready to proceed may be moved ahead of projects that received higher scores but are not ready to proceed. This decision is at the discretion of Buckeye Hills Regional Council.
- The Buckeye Hills Regional Council ARC pre-application program is a competitive process. The annual allocation of ARC funding awarded to BHRC as well as the project priority will determine how many projects can move to full application status. This means that not all projects submitted will be invited to complete a full application for funding.
- The scoring process is formed from the BHRC Executive Committee and their priority ranking of the ARC Investment Priorities.
- Additional consideration may be given to applicants requesting a smaller amount of ARC grant dollars.
- Additional consideration may be given to projects that correct existing health conditions and/or safety hazards and/or are legally compelled to be completed.
